



You may want to support some of the following needs expressed to help us maintain our buildings and grounds.

Ways to Give to the Ministries of Settle Memorial Church

In addition to making an annual pledge of financial support, members can choose to provide lasting support for the ministries of Settle Memorial through a planned gift to the church. Churches across our conference and nation regularly receive contributions of appreciated stock, bequests, charitable gift annuities, trust distributions and other gifts that are given to both fulfill the member's personal goals and to help support their church's mission. Listed here are just a few of the ways you might consider making a planned gift to support the life-giving ministry of Settle Memorial.

Gifts of Cash- Cash gifts may be deducted for one year or over six years, up to 50% of adjusted gross income. The church would welcome cash gifts and pledges.

Appreciated Stock- Appreciated stock makes an excellent gift. You may avoid capital gains taxes and receive a charitable tax deduction for the full market value of the stock.

Bequest Through Your Will- Your Last Will and Testament is your final opportunity to make a lasting gift to Settle Memorial and remind loved ones of your faith.

Gifts of Life Insurance or Real Estate - You can designate your church as the beneficiary of your life

insurance policy. As well, a gift of real estate is a popular way to make a gift to your church.

You may receive a tax deduction for the full market value and avoid future estate taxes.

Charitable Gift Annuity- In exchange for a gift of cash or securities, the UMC Foundation will pay you (or your spouse) a fixed, annual income for life. Settle Memorial Church also benefits long-term.

IRA Charitable Distribution from Retirement Account- Gifting retirement plan assets to the church may be more tax effective than using other assets. Other assets may be used to furnish heirs with an inheritance.

Because everyone's situation is unique, different options are available beyond the ones listed above. If you have a desire to discuss how you might help Settle Memorial continue to build the tradition of serving Christ in our community, country and around the world, you may want to have a discussion with an estate planner or attorney.
